- I was a member of the ATS from 1943-1945. I did my basic training in Guilford, Surrey, and then went to Edinburgh for Signal Corp training. I was training for Switchboard operations, and after completing the course was sent to London.
- I was billeted in a lovely, empty, home somewhere in the West End and then was sent to Kingston on Thames where I joined SHAEF.
- Before D-Day I was hospitalized and then posted to Montgomery's HQ in Portsmouth. Then I went to Dover (Castle) and was sent back to London.
- I married a G.I. I had met in SHAEF, and was de-mobbed.
